AHOP - APPLICATION INFORMATION

The First Nation of Na-Cho Nyäk Dun (the “FNNND”) developed the Assisted Home Ownership Program (the “AHOP”) to help Citizens meet their housing needs and to assist Citizens to become homeowners and the FNNND to provide for the housing needs of its Citizens. Each fiscal year, Council may dedicate a portion of the capital budget to assist eligible Citizens who wish to buy, build, or pay down a mortgage on a home they wish to occupy as their primary residence by way of a once in a lifetime, non-transferable subsidy of up to \$50,000.

If you wish to participate in the program, please complete and return the attached Application form and supporting documents to the AHOP office located in the Housing building. Once we receive your application, the AHOP Administrator will place you on the AHOP Priority List and you will be notified if selected for AHOP assistance. Allocation of funding under the AHOP is subject to available resources, your ranking by the Housing Committee, and your place on the Priority List.

If you are selected for assistance, final approval for funding will be conditional upon strict compliance with the requirements of all eligibility requirements of the AHOP Administrator and the AHOP Policy. We will provide you with further information if selected.

You must renew your application each fiscal year in order to maintain the status of your application. Failure to renew your application by submitting a new Application with updated information by March 31st of each year will result in your application being withdrawn without further notice.
